<u>Professional/Career Development Events:</u> In-person/virtual attendance at **two** professional/career development events is required. Other events at Georgia Tech and Emory University in the arena of professional/career development, including seminars, workshops, career panels, etc., also qualify.

Documentation: This completed **TYPED** form must be signed by the student and the faculty advisor, then submitted via the Canvas course site by the <u>last day of classes</u> of the term as per the GT Registrar's calendar. A student not officially registered for the course may not submit a participation form and will not receive future credit for any attendance in that term. For registered students, failure to submit completed form by deadline will result in a grade of U (unsatisfactory).
